

# Presenter Manual (Poster Sessions)

Poster sessions will be held only at the onsite venue. Poster presenters are required to attend onsite.

## • Presentation Time

Each poster presenters is allotted 120 minutes including 60 minutes core time (Core time)

- Speakers of an odd program numbers : first 60 minutes
- Speakers of an even program number: latter 60 minutes

## • Poster Award

## • Presentation Methods

Session will be held using Zoom meeting. Each speaker will give a short presentation (approx. 2 minutes) in order of program number order, then have a Q&A session in a Zoom breakout room.
